Phone Contact: Effective June 25th the Chazak daytime phone number is 718-570-2268.

Please do not call the other numbers day or night, even though they appear on our stationary. Phone calls to our office will be answered Monday through Thursday 9AM – 5PM (or until all the busses finish their route), and Friday 9AM – 2:00 PM. Messages cannot be left during off hours.

Camp Hours: Camp begins Thursday, June 25, 2026, and ends Friday, August 14, 2026. Camp days are Monday through Thursday starting at 9:00 AM and ending at 4:30 PM. Fridays will be until 1:30. Monday through Thursday dismissal will start at 4:15 to be out by 4:30. On Fridays dismissal will start at 1:15 PM to be out by 1:30. Parents who are picking up need to do be there at 4:15 on Weekdays and 1:15 on Fridays.

Transportation: Busing for all campers will be bus stop pick ups. We will let you know what the bus route will be and where each bus stop will be located closer to camp. Each bus will have a phone apparatus that will have WhatsApp live streaming giving each parent real time info on where the bus is located. Parents will have to have WhatsApp on their phones in order to use this service. DO NOT call that number as nobody will pick up. It will be used exclusively for Whatsapp live. We will provide that specific number to parents closer to the start of camp. Please be aware that campers must be waiting at their stops for morning pickup and someone must be waiting to receive the campers when they are dropped off or they will not be allowed off the bus! Although there will be bus counselors on every bus as we have had in the past they will not be calling prior to the start of camp. We will be emailing all the pertinent information including bus stops and approximate times for each stop prior to the start of camp. We ask for your patience and understanding with respect to the punctuality of the buses for the first few days.

Davening: All campers will daven at the day camp. Please send along a Siddur for girls going into 2nd grade and up.

Clothing Etc.: Campers must have a bathing suit, water shoes, a towel/robe for all swimming days. Additionally, All girls must have a cover up that follows the full camp Tznius guidelines (see below) for travel to and from the pool and any water park trip that they may go on. They must also come with bathing caps, as mandated by the pool that we use. For your convenience, we will enclose the number for RK Hosiery who stocks a variety of bathing caps. their number is 718-263-3939.

Campers also require a full covering smock or big t-shirt to be left at camp for Arts and Crafts days. No open toe sandals or Crocs may be worn so as to prevent foot injury. Please send your child in closed toe shoes such as sneakers. Please send along a bottle of sunscreen for your child. Please note all articles of clothing and supplies coming from home must be labeled. All items left in camp will be placed in the Lost and Found until the last day of camp after which time we will label them as “hefker”.

Dress Code/Tznius Guidelines : In accordance with our Posek in Halacha we require that all girls, no matter what age, must wear skirts and T- shirts at CHAZAK GIRLS Day Camp. Starting from the bunks of third grade and up all campers must cover knees and elbows. Additionally, parents or relatives, when picking up their children or dropping something off must also adhere to basic Tznius guidelines. Men must have a Yarmulka/Kipa or head covering (baseball cap etc.) and women must be wearing skirts that cover their knees or further and sleeves that, in the minimum, approach their elbows. Out of respect to the majority of our clientele we do request mothers/ married woman to cover their hair (even with a baseball cap) however we will not enforce that request.

Electronic Devices: We respectfully request that parents do not allow their daughters to bring any electronic devices as it takes away from the pure summer experience. **We do not allow any camper to bring cellular phones.**

Leaving Early: If a camper needs to be picked up early, the camp office should be notified prior to the pickup. No later than 2PM/12PM on weekdays/Fridays. A parent or guardian must sign the child out of camp at that time. No child may be dropped off at any other bus stop other than his own unless we receive a special request in writing.

Meals: Breakfast and hot lunch will be served daily. In most cases we will be serving individual portions to each camper. This will take place in each home room. Breakfast will be offered to campers who are interested from 9:00-9:15AM. A nutritious hot lunch will be served in the middle of the day. **Please note that Chazak Day Camp is a completely peanut free zone! We have children who are severely allergic and we cannot compromise the safety of any of our campers! Please make sure any snacks you send with your child is in compliance with this rule.** Do not send any products that contain any traces of nuts, peanuts or seeds. Examples of these are Bamba, peanut butter, granola bars, halvah, techina and some cookies. If you have a question about a snack please contact the camp office before sending it. Even the smell of some of these items may trigger an allergic reaction in some children. The lunch menu will also be sent to you.

Snack: Camp will provide refreshing snacks for all campers at the end of the day. Those who would like to bring snack from home may do so provided they are nut free and bear a reliable hashgacha. Please make sure to send only pareve snacks on fleishig/Meat days.

The Chazak Hock! : Our weekly Newsletter, where you can chap the latest news, schmooze and camp happenings, will be emailed out every week. Please take the time to read this, not only for your enjoyment but for important information and Chazak bulletins as well. It will also help you stay in tune with your children's summer schedule.

Refunds: Absence, illness Chas Vshalom, or withdrawals do not entitle parents to a refund even for uncontrolled natural or unnatural events.

Chazak Pre-School: The Chazak Pre-School program is as professional as it is warm. Under the caring leadership of our wonderful Morah's and her assistants Chazaks' Pre-School is second to none. Located in YCQ and overflowing with fun filled activities and trips it is a program we are proud to offer. Both boys Pre-School and girls Pre-School groups are located on the girls campus.

Reminder: Unless otherwise stipulated, all tuition's must be paid in full before the first day of camp. Similarly, all health forms must be submitted before the start of camp or your daughter will not be permitted to attend camp, as per New York Board of Health regulations.

Receipts: Receipts with our camp tax ID can be requested from our office throughout the summer. Please remember to do so during the summer as we may not have access to your information after camp has concluded.
